Dear Summer Arts Festival Parent:

We are so very excited that your child has been chosen to participate in our annual Summer Arts Festival. As you probably already know, this years' four-week program will end with a live production of 42<sup>nd</sup> Street.

In exchange for being a cast member in one of the most comprehensive theatre programs around, your family must pay tuition or must raise advertising dollars for our production playbill. Thus, instead of your paying the normal tuition fee of \$675.00, you can fund-raise that amount instead! Businesses you already know -or those your child introduces themselves to- can purchase one-line listings in our playbill in the amounts of \$35, \$50 or \$100, with 'Sponsor A Student' rates of up to \$675.00 each. The playbill Greetings that are placed by their family and friends (at the low cost of \$10.00 each) also go towards their \$675.00 goal.

At this time, we would also like to ensure your cooperation with our commitment to remain in the cast contract. If the required amount of \$675.00 is not raised, ***the students' family must fulfill the difference.*** Those who do not raise this amount are not allowed to perform in the production and must pay the balance owed. By signing this letter, you acknowledge this Festival policy.
